Agenda Item#6- Financial Statements for February 29, 2020

Richard Bernier (The Balmoral Group) provided the balance sheet, profit and loss statement, cash receipts journal and cash disbursements journal for review by the committee. The increase in grants was the only item of note. Reports showing pre-award grant funding and corresponding check detail which includes administrative expenses were presented. Matt Posner (Escambia) questioned on the check detail if NGN costs are associated with county projects. Richard Bernier (The Balmoral Group) replied that they all pertained to preaward county projects. Matt Posner asked if the project number could be added on the check detail. Richard Bernier (The Balmoral Group) said he would look into that for the next report. Lane Lynchard (Santa Rosa) made the motion to approve the financial statements, second by Matt Posner (Escambia)

Agenda Item #7-February 2020 Budget Summary and Project Status Expenditure Reports

Richard Bernier (The Balmoral Group) presented the budget summary and status of project expenditures to date. There was now some activity happening in the SEP. Chair Carnahan asked about the projects on hold. Valerie answered that they were county level decisions.

Richard Bernier (The Balmoral Group) gave a presentation of the current Trust Fund balance and pending Grant applications for SEP implementation. There were no comments or questions on this item.

Valerie Seidel (The Balmoral Group) provided an update on the Audit status. A couple of items were being changed since the last time it was reported. They were splitting out all the SEP grants, so it showed SSEP and PSEP, and showing a carryover from a previous year so it was not a negative budget. Otherwise the report was the same.

Agenda Item #12 – Risk and Audit Update

Valerie Seidel (The Balmoral Group) scheduled an internal control review by RESTORE. RESTORE visited The Balmoral Group office and reviewed procurement process, grant application process, payment request process, all file and documentation management procedures and IT security and other general accounting. Generally, they were complementary of the setup. RESTORE made Balmoral aware of some training that they were providing. Valerie Seidel (The Balmoral Group) noted that the planning grant will be audited at some point. They had been asked to prepare the risk rubric per grant application. This would be brought up at the Executive Committee meeting where discussion would need to happen regarding assigning risk ratings to each county. Also, the Board delegated to staff the ability to renegotiate the fiscal agent contract between periodic meetings with Leon County. The Balmoral Group had a meeting a couple weeks ago with Leon County who has not requested any increase in funds at this time. There were no questions on these items.

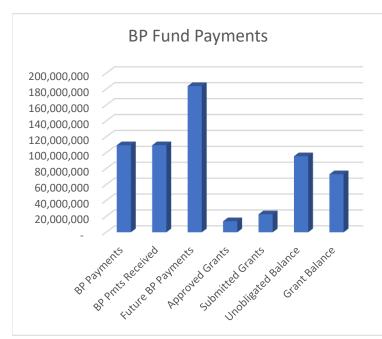

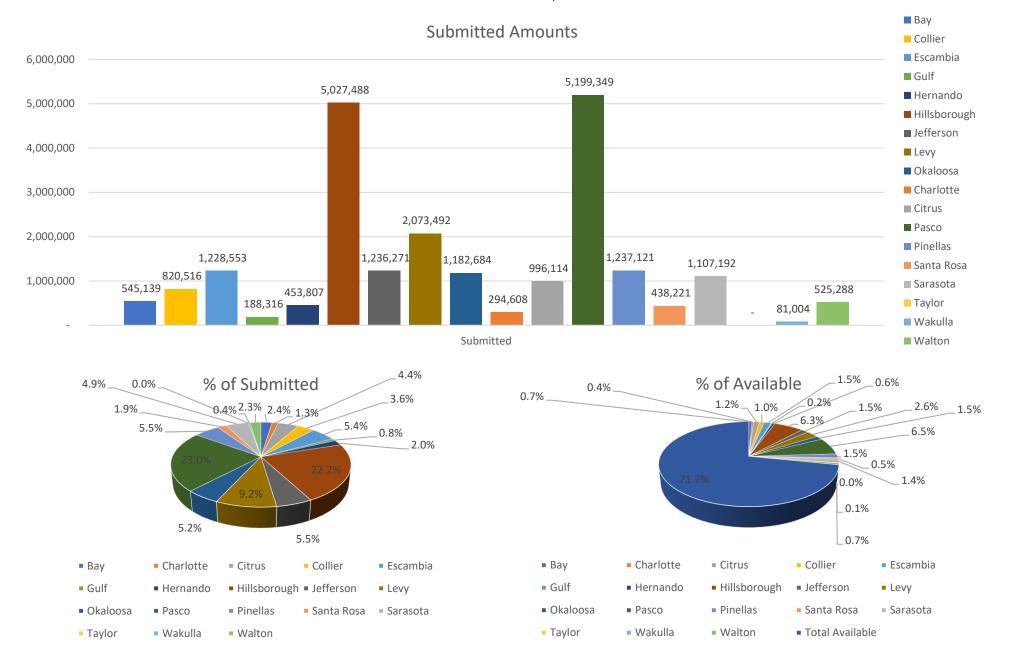
